TRICKS CHECKLIST: PERFORMER



Instructions: Include this page with the AKC Trick Dog Title Application.

A TOTAL OF 10 TRICKS from the Novice, Intermediate and Advanced titles ARE REQUIRED TO EARN THE TRICK DOG PERFORMER TITLE. (Must have all 3 titles on record).

The dog/handler must perform 10 Tricks that include at least 2 Intermediate Tricks and 2 Advanced Tricks.

The tricks may have theme or story (e.g., "This is my dog Princess. Princess loves school-here's what she does at school. She plays ball on the play ground, and then she takes a nap," etc.

\* If your tricks routine had a story, please tell us the basic idea on the back of this page. WHILE A STORY IS NOT REQUIRED, THIS CAN BE VERY ENTERTAINING AT SHOWS, EVENTS AND IN THERAPY SETTINGS.

\* If your routine has a story, you can tell the story yourself (see example of Princess above) or you can have a narrator read the story to give you cues about the next trick.

\* No food lures (using food to guide the dog into position) may be used in the Performer title.

\* Food and/or clickers may be used as reinforcers (after a correct behavior).

AKC Trick Dog launched on May 1, 2017. Applicants for the Performer title had to send a video to AKC.

As of November 3, 2017, CGC Evaluators may evaluate Performer dogs along with the other tricks titles.
